## Voting By Proxy

A Form of Proxy accompanies this Notice of Annual Meeting.

1. A unitholder entitled to attend and vote is entitled to appoint not more than two proxies. If the unitholder appoints two proxies and does not specify the proportion or number of the unitholder's votes to be voted by each proxy, each proxy may exercise half of the votes. An additional Form of Proxy will be supplied by APA Unit Registry by calling (02) 8280 7132.
2. If the unitholder is a corporation, the Form of Proxy must be executed under its common seal, or under the hand of two directors or a director and a company secretary of the company. If there is a sole director who is also the sole secretary, the form of proxy must be signed by that person.
3. A proxy need not be a unitholder of Australian Pipeline Trust.
4. If a unitholder appoints the Chairman as its proxy and does not otherwise direct the Chairman how to vote, the unitholder is deemed to have directed the Chairman to vote in favour of Messrs Bennett, Ford and Wright.

Members who are entitled to attend and vote at the Annual Meeting may appoint a proxy. A proxy can, therefore, be either an individual or a body corporate. Should you appoint a body corporate as your proxy, that body corporate will need to ensure that it:

- ◆ appoints an individual as its corporate representative to exercise its powers at meetings, in accordance with section 250D of the Corporations Act 2001 (Cth); and
- ◆ provides satisfactory evidence of the appointment of its corporate representative prior to commencement of the meeting.

If such evidence is not received before the meeting, then the body corporate (through its representative) will not be permitted to act as your proxy.

Appointing a proxy does not mean that you are not able to attend the meeting, however, the Corporations Act 2001(Cth) specifies that the presence of a unitholder at a meeting suspends his or her proxy's rights to speak and vote. Accordingly you will be asked to revoke your proxy when registering at the meeting.
