APA GROUP SIGNS TWO GAS TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENTS FOR THE MIDWEST REGION OF WA.

APA Group today announced it had signed two Gas Transportation Agreements for the fast-growing Mid West region of WA - one for its wholly owned Parmelia Gas Pipeline and associated Mondarra Storage Facility and the other for its 50 percent-owned MidWest Pipeline.

APA Group signed a five-year Gas Storage and Transportation Agreement (GSTA) with Eneabba Gas Limited under which gas will be supplied to Eneabba Gas' Centauri 1 power station. Eneabba Gas received final regulatory approval in March to build the 168-megawatt (MW) power station, eight kilometres east of Dongara. The agreement allows for up to 46.6 terajoules (TJ) of gas per day to be transported via the Parmelia Gas Pipeline coupled with storage arrangements using the Mondarra Storage Facility. The agreement is for five years and can be extended for a further five years.

Under the second GTA, the MidWest Pipeline Joint Venture (MWPJV) – jointly owned by APA Group and State-owned power company, Horizon Power -- signed a 15-year agreement to transport gas for Precious Metals Australia Limited's Windimurra vanadium mine. The gas will be transported via the 365 km-long MidWest pipeline which was originally built to facilitate the development of the vanadium mine in 1999.

The two agreements highlight the rapid pace of development and growing energy demand in the MidWest of WA and the important role APA Group plays in providing infrastructure to the region.
