



## Extension of Time to Make Submissions Western Slopes Pipeline Project Application for Authority to Survey

The Department has extended the date for making submissions in relation to the application for an authority to survey under the *Pipelines Act 1967* from the APA Group in respect of the Western Slopes Pipeline Project.

If granted, the authority to survey will be subject to accompanying proposed conditions imposed by the Minister for Energy and Utilities.

Details of the application, including a list of affected land parcels (with an erratum relating to some Local Government Areas, Counties and Parishes), a map showing the broad area covered by the application, and the proposed conditions, are available from the NSW Governments' Have Your Say website at:

If you are an owner or occupier of the affected land parcels and despite the proposed conditions, you have concerns that you may be adversely affected by the proposed authority to survey your land, you may contact the Department regarding your concerns and provide evidence to support your claims. Landowners or occupiers of affected land parcels that have already made submissions need not make further submissions.

Submissions are open until 5pm **Friday 2 June 2017**.
