
Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network 2018-19 Gas Distribution Network Tariff Variation Proposal

The AER approves the proposed distribution tariff variation notice for the Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network for the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019, which was initially submitted by APA Group to the AER on 18 April and subsequently revised on 9 May 2018.

The AER has reviewed the revised version of the proposed tariff variation notice against the provisions of the Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network access arrangement, and found the proposed tariff variation to be compliant with those provisions.

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STATEMENT OF REASONS

Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network distribution tariff variation for 2018-19

On 18 April 2018, APA Group applied to the AER for variation of the Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network distribution tariffs for the period 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019. APA Group updated its application on 9 May 2018. The application is based on the 2004-19 access arrangement approved by IPART on 8 December 2005 and the 2008 amendments approved by the AER on 15 August 2008 and 10 October 2008.

The AER has considered APA Group's application in accordance with sections 3.2, 3.3, 3.4 and 3.4A of the Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network 2004-19 access arrangement.

The AER is satisfied that APA Group's application complies with the relevant principles and formulae set out in section 3.3 of the Central Ranges Pipeline Gas Network 2004-19 access arrangement.

Having considered APA Group's proposal of 9 May April 2018 stating the nature of the proposed tariff, the AER approves these tariffs for commencement on 1 July 2018.

The approved 2018-19 distribution tariffs are set out in the section below.
