Information Register

Directlink is a Transmission Network Service Providers (TNSPs) and provides transmission services under the National Electricity Law (NEL). Directlink must therefore comply with the Australian Energy Regulator's (AER) Ring-fencing Guideline for Electricity Transmission (Version 4) that was published by the AER on 1 March 2023 (the Guideline).

Clause 4.2.4 of the Guideline requires a TNSP to establish and maintain a register of:

- related electricity service providers and other legal entities who have requested access to ring fenced information (see clause 4.2.4(a) of the Guideline); and
- identify the kind of information requested and describe the information in sufficient detail to enable other legal entities to make an informed decision about whether to request that kind of information (see clause 4.2.4(b) of the Guideline)

This document is Directlink's information register in accordance with clause 4.2.4 of the Guideline.
